



Imagine Engineering Coloring Contest

The Imagine Engineering Coloring Contest is a statewide, youth education program for second graders. It was established in 1999 and is sponsored by the Engineers Foundation of Ohio. This education program allows second grade teachers to schedule an in-class visit from a local member of the Ohio Society of Professional Engineers (OSPE). Volunteers visit classrooms in November, December and January to talk with the children about what engineers do for a living. At the end of the presentation, the OSPE volunteer distributes a small gift to each student and coloring contest materials.

A student may enter the coloring contest by drawing and coloring a picture of an engineer at work. This year's theme is "Not All Engineers Drive a Train". Contest winners will be announced during National Engineers Week in February.

The Toledo Chapter of OSPE will award the top three local winners a family membership to the Toledo Zoo.
